

#### **Cell Modem Contract Details**

Operator will sign a standard operator agreement to participate in Big Buck HD online. Part of the agreement states that he will be able to activate cell service at any game machine.

During the registration process at the game, the operator will choose which connection type he would like to use. If the operator would like to use cell modem, then he will opt in to a cellular contract at the game for that cell modem.

To opt in, while choosing the connection type the operator will select the cell option and will then be prompted with the terms of the cell agreement. If he selects the "Agree" button, he will automatically be placed into a 2 year contract for the modem in that game.

If the operator selects the "Decline" button, the modem will be turned off and he can establish a connection using WiFi or ethernet. He can re-activate his modem at any time by calling CoinUp support at Raw Thrills.

#### WiFi\*

#### WiFi Connectivity'

- Connect to location's WiFi with the pre-installed WiFi device.
- If using WiFi, operator will need to know general information about the network at the location.
- Info needed: SSID, encryption type, encryption key (password), channel.
- If the network is open/disabled, then the operator will only need to scan for the network and the system will do the rest.
- IP Address can be obtained automatically via DHCP or statically configured




- \* Each location is different and operators need to understand that WiFi is not always the most reliable choice. They need to come prepared with the above info in order to have a smooth connection and consult the operating manual for help. May require that operator has access to location's router to view/change configuration.
- \* Warning: Credit Card functionality is only available on secured WiFi Networks.

#### **Ethernet**

#### **Ethernet Connectivity**

- Operators can take advantage of the location's internet service. Just connect an ethernet cable to the computer in the game.
- IP Address can be obtained automatically via DHCP or statically configured
- Once connected, register the machine using Operator ID and PIN







### **Operator Registration**

Operator must be registered with Raw Thrills as an online CoinUp operator.

- If they have an Operator ID from Raw Thrills then skip to step 3 (Installing the game)
- If they are not registered, follow these steps

#### **Operator Account Registration**



- Many operators are already registered. Operators that aren't registered will need to complete the CoinUp Registration Packet
  - Registration Packet can be found at www.coinup.com/coinupregistration.pdf
    - It is suggested that you print a copy of the registration packet for each sales presentation
- It consists of an Operator Agreement, ACH Bank form, and Operator Registration Form
  - It's important that operators provide a valid email address.
     They will also need to provide payment information (either Bank information or Credit Card information, we don't need both)

### Step Two: Receiving Operator ID

- Once registration packet is submitted, operators will receive registration confirmation via email containing Operator ID and PIN within 1-3 business days.
- Using this email, Operators will set a password for their web account as well as receive valuable game registration information.
- Within 1-2 weeks operators will receive an Operator Card in the mail which they can use for quick log in when registering their machines. Operators DO NOT need to wait for this card to begin registering their games.

#### **Step Three: Power Up Game**

- When the game is turned on for the first time, some setup will be required and the operator will be walked through a series of steps.
  - Gun Calibration, Screen Latency Test, Screen Adjustments, Operator Login,
     Cabinet Registration, and Connectivity Wizard



# Step Four: Gun Calibration, Screen Latency Test, and Screen Adjustments


- The first three steps pertain to setting up the monitor and operators can follow the easy on-screen instructions
- After the initial setup, each of these steps can be accessed through the diagnostics menu for further review



#### **Step Five: Operator Login**

- Operators will log into their account using the Operator ID and PIN provided to them. They can also swipe their operator card for quick access.
- If in the very rare event that an operator is on site and hasn't registered an online account with Raw Thrills, he will be able to create an account from the game. (We should try everything in our power to make sure this does not happen and get them registered before they go on location)
  - To register an account at the game, they will need to provide all pertinent information, including a valid email address, company name, phone number, etc. They will also need to provide a credit card for billing purposes.

# **Game Installation (Continued)**



- Once the operator is logged into his account, he will need to register his game
  - He will enter the location name, address, phone number, time zone, etc.
  - It is important that the operator correctly compete this section so that the game appears in the location finder properly for players to find.

# Step Seven: Choose Connection Type with Connectivity Wizard

- Operator must choose how he would like to connect his game (ethernet, cell, or WiFi)
  - Cell modem is pre-installed and is ready to go
    - Operator must have a signed operator agreement to use cell
    - They will be able to opt in to the cell plan by agreeing to the terms and conditions at the cell modem selection screen.
  - If an operator chooses to not use cell, the cell modem will be turned off.

    He can reactivate the modem by contacting CoinUp Support at Raw Thrills.
  - WiFi device is pre-installed and is ready to go
  - Operator must have the network credentials in order to complete WiFi set up
    - SSID, Encryption Type, Encryption Key/Pass Phrase (password), and Channel
  - Following the on-screen WiFi set up instructions, operators can connect to the location's WiFi
  - Ethernet is another connection option
    - Operator needs to connect a Cat-5 (High Speed internet only) cable to the port on the back of the computer.

### **Additional Information**

#### **Registration Required**

Games will not function unless they are registered. Please make sure that operators have everything they need before going on location to install a game.

#### **No Connection Prior to Registration**

If in the event that an operator can not connect his game due to circumstances outside of his control (i.e. location is bringing in internet but not until next week) he will be allowed to run his game in an offline grace period for 30 days. This will allow the basic game to be playable but will have minimal features. After 30 days the game will go into an unplayable state until registered.

#### **Loss of Connection**

Once a game is registered it's possible that it will lose connection from time to time. If a game loses connection, it will lose certain online features like the ability to play tournaments, showdown, etc. As soon as the game regains it's connection all of those features will return automatically. All online casual play data that occurs while a game is not connecting will be stored on the hard drive and will be sent up when a connection is regained.

If a game is offline for 30 days, that game will revert back to an unregistered state and will become unplayable. Operators need to make sure their games do not get into this state otherwise their game will be unusable.

# Selecting the Right LCD Makes a BIG Difference!

#### **Ensuring Maximum Performance**

In order to ensure the highest possible collections and performance of your Big Buck HD Game, you should purchase a 1080p LCD with LOW INPUT LAG. The extra amount you spend for this valuable feature will be more than offset by the improved earnings and player satisfaction.

#### Input Lag, Game Mode, and Response Time

INPUT LAG is the amount of time it takes for an image to go from the cable on the back of the monitor to the screen. INPUT LAG is a critical factor for real-time video games because high lag time leads to player confusion, disorientation, and dissatisfaction. INPUT LAG is easily measurable and the effects are obvious.

GAME MODE is a special setting on certain LCD TV's and monitors that minimizes INPUT LAG.

RESPONSE TIME is a marketing term referring to how little ghosting is on the screen. Lower response time means less ghosting. However, in order to minimize RESPONSE TIME, the LCD firmware will generally increase INPUT LAG. To further reduce ghosting, many displays have a DYNAMIC MODE, which makes the INPUT LAG even higher.

Other manufacturers' video games may not require GAME MODE because they do not have the real-time, high reflex action required from Big Buck HD. In other words:

If there is some delay between rolling a trackball and the golfer swinging, it does not lead to disorientation or confusion. However, suppose a player swings the gun from the left side of the screen to the right and fires a shot. If the shot shows up on the left side of the screen, the player will be understandably upset.

#### **Summary**

GAME MODE is mandatory for Big Buck HD to minimize INPUT LAG

RESPONSE TIME has nothing to do with INPUT LAG

DYNAMIC MODE increases INPUT LAG (makes it worse)

### **Purchasing a Monitor**

#### Which 1080p Monitor Should You Buy?

Generally speaking, the value brands should be avoided. They typically do not offer GAME MODE and have poor color reproduction as well. The value brands to avoid are **Westinghouse**, **Dynex**, **Vizio**, **RCA** and **Insignia**. Some of these monitor manufacturers support GAME MODE but you should be careful and check the manual.

There are many quality LCD manufacturers that offer GAME MODE: **Sharp**, **Samsung**, **LG**, **Panasonic**, **Toshiba**, **Sony**, **Philips**. Note that not all monitors offered by these manufacturers have GAME MODE. Refer to the monitor's manual for confirmation.

As of April 2012, the price difference between the least-expensive 42" LCD TV and the least expensive TV with GAME MODE is \$100. There is a similar price differential between 55" LCD TV's.

#### **How Do You Determine If Your Monitor Supports GAME MODE?**

- 1. Visit the manufacturer's website.
- 2. Locate the "Support" or "Product Support" page.
- 3. Type in as much of the model number of the LCD as possible (hint: the model number usually contains the screen size, e.g. "LC42SV49U". Do not use the retailer's SKU)
- 4. Look for a link to "Downloads", or just locate the "User's Manual"
- 5. Open the User's Manual (an Adobe PDF File)
- 6. Using Acrobat (or the viewer inside your browser), search for "GAME MODE".

  If the manual states that GAME MODE is an option, the monitor is ok.
- 7. If there is no result for GAME MODE, check the manual for "Picture Settings".

  Under picture settings, if there is a "GAME" setting, the monitor is ok.

#### To Find a Laggy Monitor (and Quantify Lag):

Take a video card with two outputs, run one (VGA) into a CRT, run the other into an LCD.

Then put the display card into "clone display" mode, so it will show the same exact data on both monitors.

Then, run the following: http://tft.vanity.dk/inputlag.html

Get a digital camera, set the MAX exposure (min time)

Snap a picture of BOTH screens at the same time

The differential in time showing on the screens will show lag
