Manx TT Twin features two skill levels and the ability to link up to 8 players.


The Laxey Coast course is for inexperienced racers but they will soon be ready for the advanced level, the TT course itself.

The racer can select automatic transmission (AT) or 6-speed manual transmission (MT)


and the racing bike is steered by leaning to the left or right sides.
